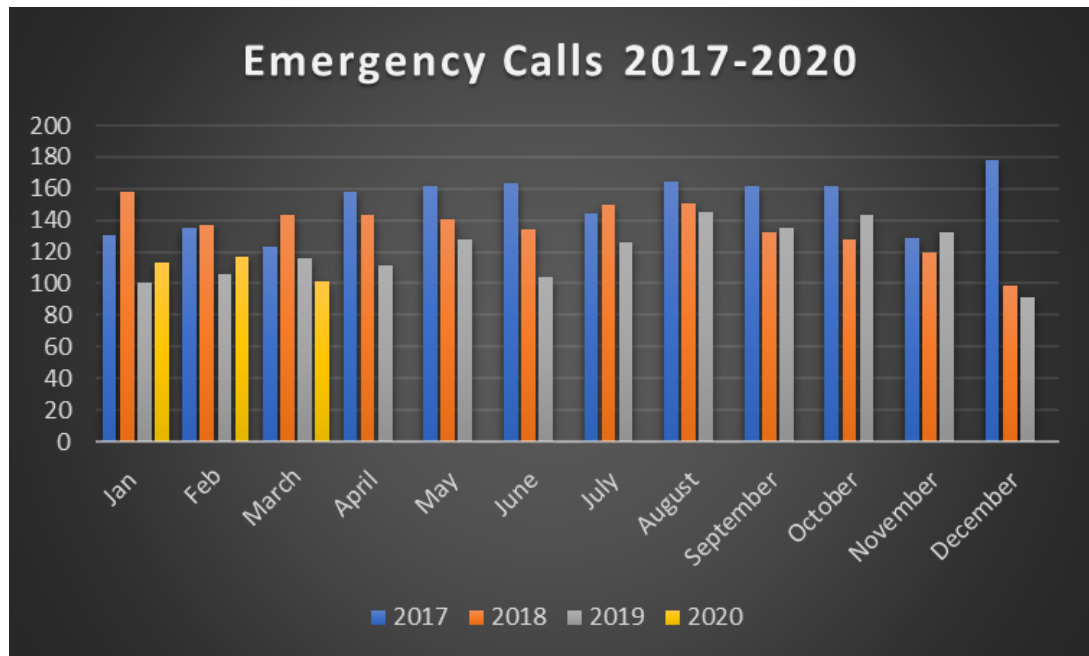
The mission of the Tubac Fire District is to create a safer environment within our community in order to increase the quality of life which our citizens may enjoy.

Chief Horvath prepared a document in response to questions posed by members of the Station #1 committee for their first meeting. The document is included with this month's staff report.

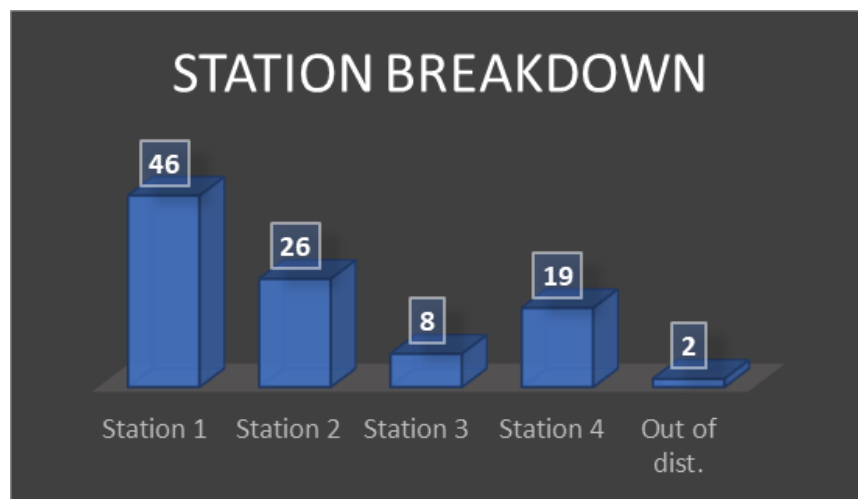
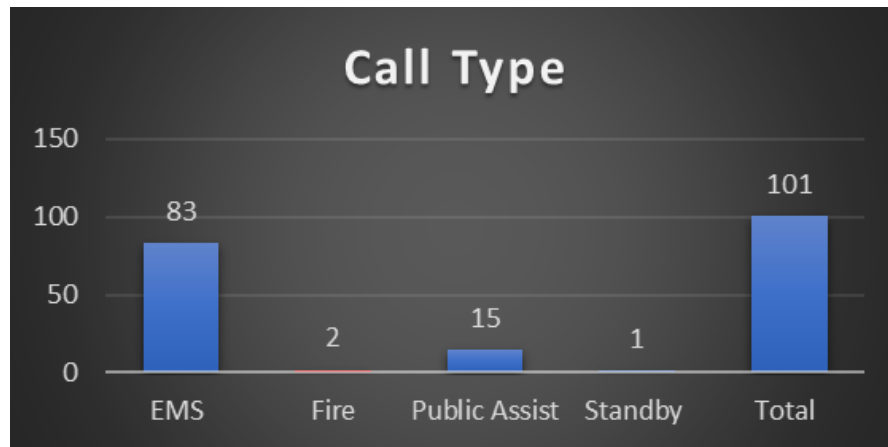
Operations Update

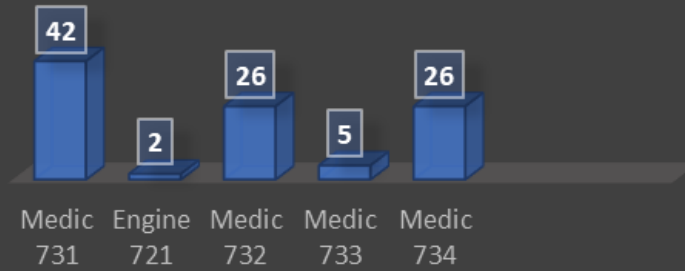
Station 1 – Average 50 unique incidents per month

Station 2 – Average 51 unique incidents per month

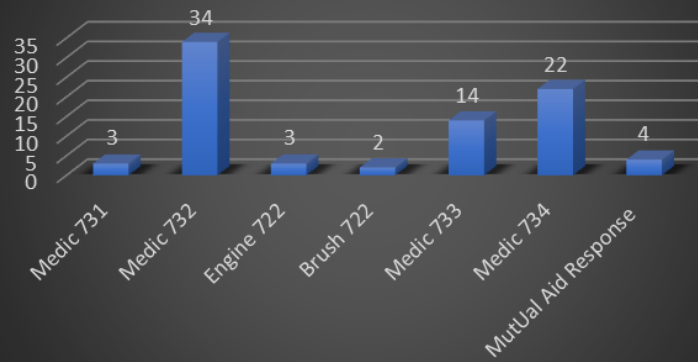
Station 3 – Average 10 unique incidents per month

RESPONSE BY PRIMARY UNIT

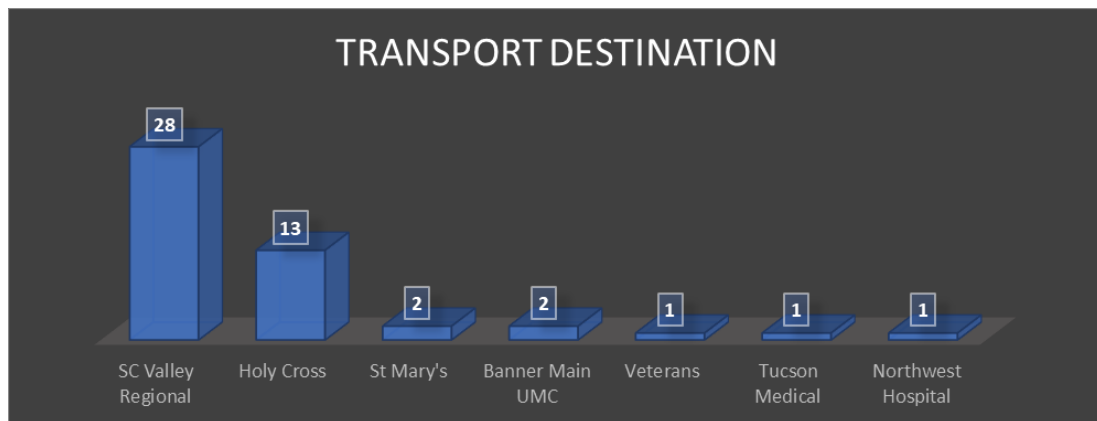
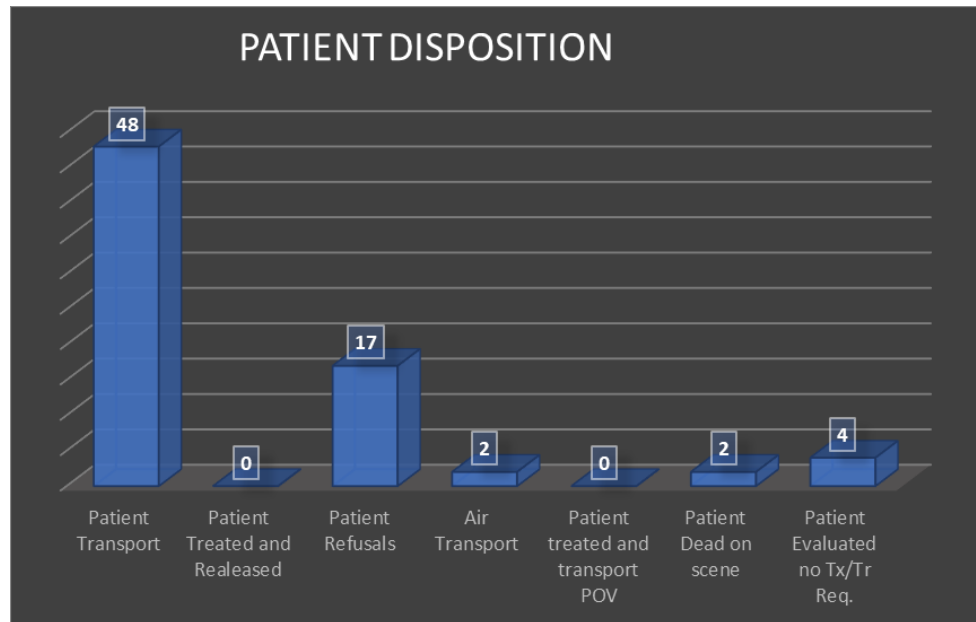


RESPONSE AS SECONDARY UNIT



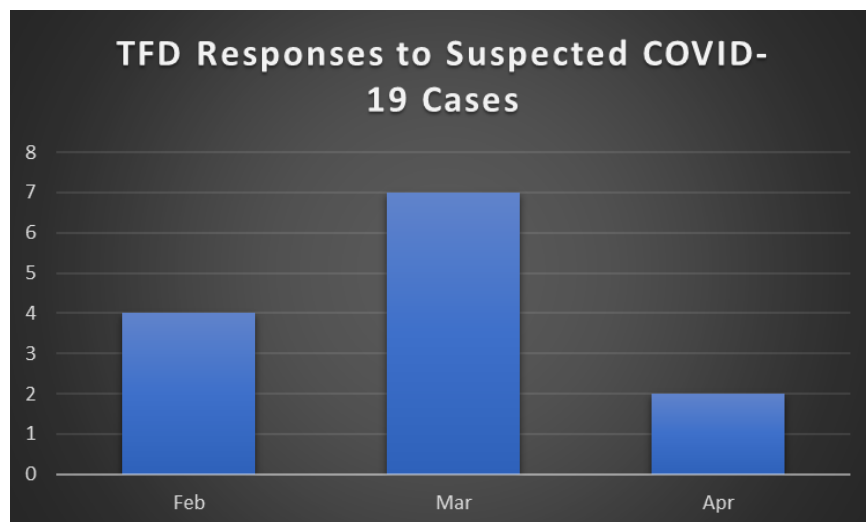
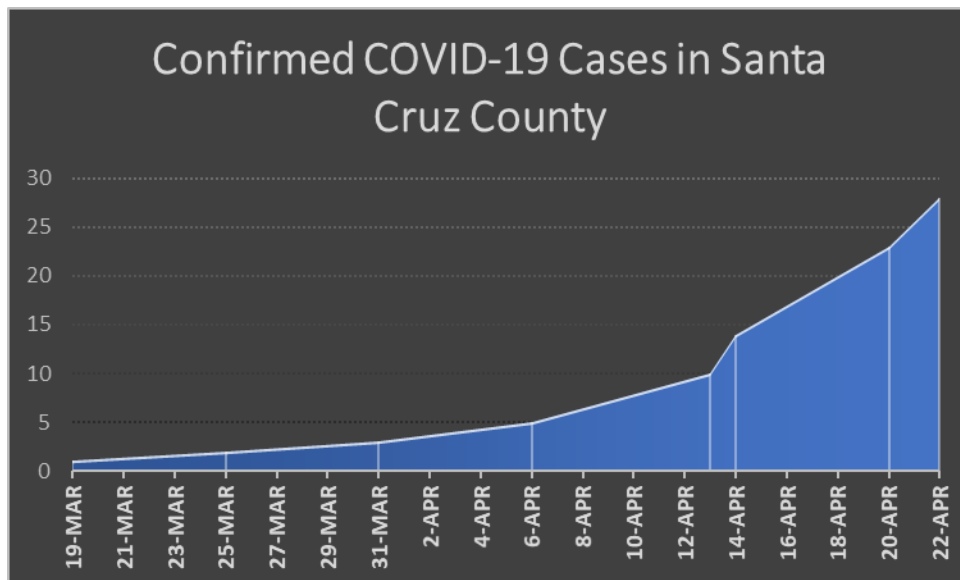
Emergency Medical Services Response

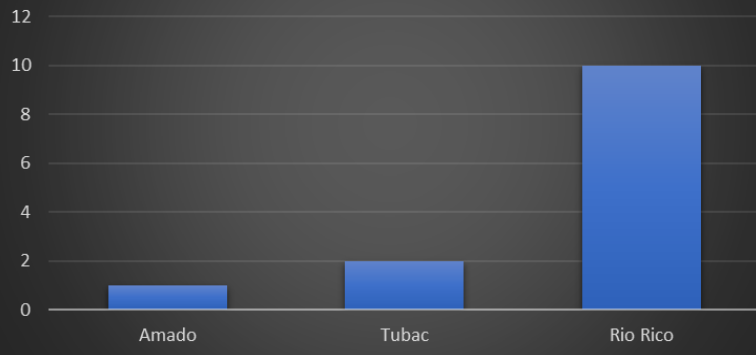
