TUBAC FIRE DISTRICT BOARD MEETING MINUTES October 30, 2013

- 1. <u>Call to Order and Pledge of Allegiance</u>: The meeting was called to order at 9:00 am by Richard Lockwood. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
- 2. Roll call of Board Members: Board Members present were Richard Lockwood, Dottie Bergmann, Herb Wisdom, Randy Williams and Bill Kirkpatrick. Also present were Chief Kevin Keeley, Asst.
